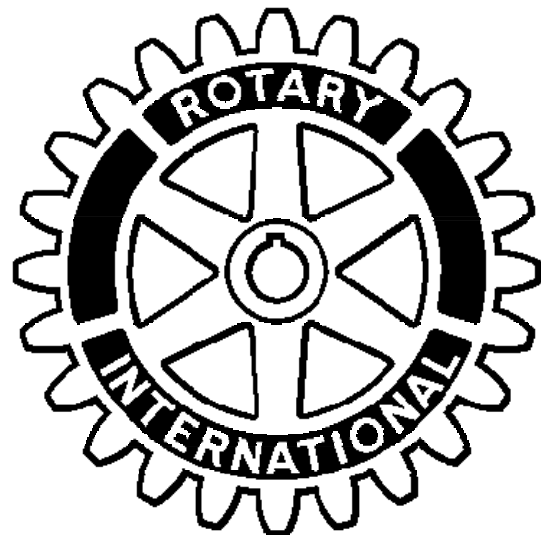
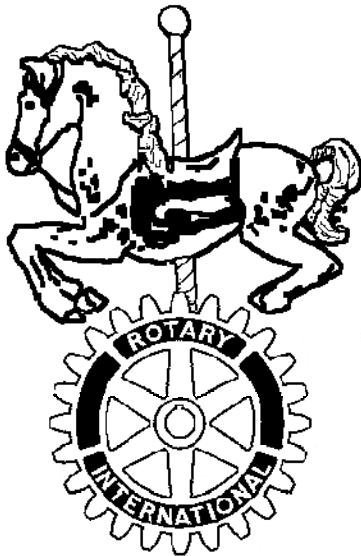
Lawrenceburg Rotarians, spouses, family, and friends celebrate their 2008 Champion of Champions Award.
